

Has Our Messiah Come?

The question “who are you people” is often asked us in Israel, in answer to which we shall again explain that our name in English “Church of God” was given to this people nearly two thousand years ago, and repeated twelve times in the New Testament, in which period we were nearly 100 percent Jews. We have come down from that time with the Jews, and as Jews, have been persecuted, and thousands died with them under the iron hand of Roman Catholicism.

We have never as a people, embraced the teaching and practices of Rome taken from paganism, or those adopted from Babylon.

There are several thousand of these people scattered all over the world of this same faith, and the Jews are still, and always have been, their warm friends. The main difference between them religiously, is that they look for the first coming of our Messiah, while we look for His second coming soon. We believe that Isaiah the 53rd chapter should be replaced in the Synagogue Sabbath readings. This would pave the way, as many leading Jews admit, for the people to accept the Messiah born in Bethlehem, (Micah 5: 2) as the sacrifice prepared by the Father for the sins of Israel, as stated in this wonderful chapter.

The TRUE religion of heaven for mankind is not one polluted with paganism as modern Christianity. Neither is it one of narrow mindedness, where leaders and others “Strain at a gnat,

and swallow a camel," or practise coercion to bring people to their way of thinking.

The true religion is that of Abraham, and David, who understood that divine LAW "of The Spirit of LIFE" (Romans 8:2), by which it becomes man's nature to walk in the way of the Holy Commandments, just the same as it is the nature of the orange tree to bear only oranges.

David understood this divine law, and prayed that the Heavenly Father would not withdraw from him "His Holy Spirit." His prayer was "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right Spirit within me - Take not THY HOLY SPIRIT from me." Psalms 51:10, 11. See also Luke 11:11-13.

Like magnetic electricity in a piece of steel this heavenly virtue is to the human body and soul. The person becomes charged with a Spirit of goodness, and power in accomplishments for the good of others, that men and women are made better and more like God. This is the coming religion of Israel. It is the "Old Time Jewish Religion" founded by Moses, and Christ, revealing to mankind, the power from heaven that charges and transforms people into the likeness of God, so that the golden rule becomes their nature. To do unto others, as you would have them do to you, Luke 6:31.

that time it was owned by an Arab to whom I paid a little money to see it. There were no buildings there then. It had just been discovered. I saw the pictures of the five loaves and two fishes in mosaic on the floor of the old synagogue, also the baskets full of fragments, and a picture of the building. I took pictures as it was then, and still have them. It has been changed much however, since the Catholics took over there.

Jews Remain Jews but Better Jews

When Jews read Isaiah 9:6, 7; also 7:14-16, and 11:1-4, and the 53rd chapter, repent and accept Yahshua as their Messiah, they become better Jews than before. They pray to the Father in His name and receive the HOLY SPIRIT according to the promise, which changes stony hearts to hearts of flesh. Ezekiel 36:24-26. They are then better Jews, and remain with the Jews as Jews, the same as before, teaching others this one addition to their faith.

Possessing the power of the Holy Spirit, synagogue prayers are neither read nor memorized, but direct from their hearts, the words are accompanied with power, that softens hearts, and brings them in love and unity with the Father and with one another.

A Jew can believe that the Messiah has come, and is the child born in Bethlehem, and still remain a Jew, much better than he can deny there is a God, become a Communist or an atheist and still be considered a Jew, as commonly practiced today in Israel.

A few years ago if a person was found in possession of a New Testament or seen reading one, he was classed as a Christian, and shunned by most all Jews. Now the New Testament is taught in some government schools, found in libraries or on the table of reading rooms in thousands of homes and among most all leaders. It has become popular to own a New Testament, and it is now a common saying in Israel that it does not make a person a Christian to own or to read a New Testament.

Some years ago a person who openly confessed that he believed the Messiah had come, and "Yahshua ha Meshia," born in Bethlehem, that person was put down as a Christian, and firms or business places hiring him were boycotted by the Orthodox and others.
